During the undertaking of any project there is always value conducting a peer review with an independent body who has experience of the same or similar work. DBD staff are experts in most aspect of the nuclear industry, from design to commissioning to operations and safety and project management through financial and planning.

What is the value of this Offering?

DBD undertakes independent reviews of major programmes of work and projects for Clients to ensure Stakeholder and Regulator alignment, and successful delivery of business requirements.

A peer review may be focused on any one aspect of delivery or across the total programme of work or business area. The reviews will highlight areas where the work is proceeding well, or not so well, where resource should be allocated, or repositioned. In addition to highlighting potential problem areas DBD could provide support in most project areas.

In addition DBD can apply peer review to design, commissioning and plant operations or other relevant technical aspects relevant to projects, processes or plants
